

 PERSONAL ANECDOTES THAT HIGHLIGHT THE HERO'S DEDICATION AND COURAGE.












ENROLLMENT OF SENIOR WING CADETS












































HAR GHAR TIRANGA CAMP CAMPAIGN

- ON 3RD SEPTEMBER 2024, THE SW NCC CADETS OF A.P.SEN MEMORIAL GIRLS PG COLLEGE UNDER THE AEGIS OF 20 UP GIRLS BATTALION NCC, LUCKNOW GOT THE OPPORTUNITY TO VISIT THE "KNOW YOUR ARMY" FAIR BEING HELD AT SURYA KHEL PARISAR FROM 3RD SEPTEMBER 2024 TO 5TH SEPTEMBER 2024.
- > THIS EVENT WAS ORGANIZED TO PROVIDE THE GENERAL PUBLIC, ESPECIALLY STUDENTS, WITH INSIGHTS INTO THE WORKINGS, EQUIPMENT, AND LIFESTYLE OF THE INDIAN ARMY. 
GANDHI JAYANTI AND LAL BAHADUR SHASTRI JAYANTI

- ON OCTOBER 2ND 2024 ON THE OCCASION OF GANDHI JAYANTI AND LAL BAHADUR SHASTRI JAYANTI, THE NCC CADETS OF A.P. SEN MEMORIAL GIRLS PG COLLEGE ORGANIZED AN ENGAGING AND IMPACTFUL NUKKAD NATAK ON BLOOD DONATION. THE EVENT WAS HELD AS PART OF THE INSTITUTION'S SOCIAL OUTREACH PROGRAM AND AIMED TO RAISE AWARENESS ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF BLOOD DONATION.
- THE NUKKAD NATAK WAS PERFORMED IN AN OPEN PUBLIC SPACE, DRAWING THE ATTENTION OF PASSERSBY, STUDENTS, AND OTHER MEMBERS.
- > THE PLAY EFFECTIVELY DISPELLED THESE MYTHS, EDUCATING THE AUDIENCE ON THE SAFETY AND SIMPLICITY OF THE DONATION PROCESS, AS WELL AS THE FACT THAT BLOOD DONATION IS CRUCIAL FOR SAVING LIVES IN EMERGENCIES.
- IN THEIR PERFORMANCE, THE CADETS EMPHASIZED THAT BLOOD DONATION IS NOT ONLY SAFE BUT ALSO BENEFICIAL FOR BOTH THE DONOR AND THE RECIPIENT. THEY ENCOURAGED HEALTHY INDIVIDUALS, ESPECIALLY THE YOUTH, TO BECOME REGULAR DONORS, REMINDING THEM THAT A SINGLE PINT OF BLOOD CAN SAVE UP TO THREE LIVES. THE EMOTIONAL IMPACT OF THE NATAK WAS ENHANCED BY PERSONAL TESTIMONIES OF CADETS WHO HAD DONATED BLOOD AND BY HIGHLIGHTING REAL-LIFE CASES WHERE BLOOD DONORS HAD HELPED SAVE LIVES.
- > THE EVENT CONCLUDED WITH A STRONG APPEAL TO THE AUDIENCE TO STEP FORWARD AND DONATE BLOOD, REMINDING THEM THAT DONATING BLOOD IS NOT JUST A NOBLE ACT BUT A CIVIC DUTY. THE RESPONSE FROM THE COMMUNITY WAS OVERWHELMINGLY POSITIVE, WITH MANY ATTENDEES EXPRESSING A NEWFOUND UNDERSTANDING OF THE IMPORTANCE OF BLOOD DONATION.
- > THE NUKKAD NATAK ON BLOOD DONATION WAS A RESOUNDING SUCCESS, RAISING AWARENESS AND ENCOURAGING 102 PARTICIPATION IN AN ESSENTIAL HUMANITARIAN CAUSE. THE EFFORTS OF THE NCC CADETS WERE LAUDED FOR THEIR CREATIVITY, DEDICATION, AND THEIR CONTRIBUTION TO PROMOTING A LIFE-SAVING PRACTICE.














YOGA DAY










INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA

- COMMENCED FROM MEERUT ON 1ST JANUARY 2025 AND IS TRAVELLING THROUGH MAJOR CENTRES OF THE 1857 UPRISING SUCH AS BAREILLY, LUCKNOW, PRAYAGRAJ, VARANASI, KANPUR, JHANSI, GWALIOR, AGRA, AND MATHURA, BEFORE CULMINATING AT NEW DELHI ON 27TH JANUARY 2025.
- COVERING A TOTAL DISTANCE OF 2000 KM IN 17 CYCLING DAYS, THE TEAM COMPRISES 15 NCC CADETS, INCLUDING FIVE GIRL CADETS FROM THE UP DIRECTORATE.ON 4TH JANUARY 2025,












































































INTERACTION WITH DG NCC VISIT
