LOCATION:

A. P. Sen Memorial Girls' PG College is a 100 year old premier girls' institution of the city. A. P. Sen College has a unique advantage, being located in the hearts of bustling Charbagh area while enjoying the calm of sprawling gardens and running over a campus area of approximately. 3 acres. Established in 1955, it is a government aided college located 500 meters from Charbagh Railway Station with easy access to transport and bus facilities.

BRIEF HISTORY:

The institution originated in the form of MAHAKALI PATHSHALA in the year 1902. It was given recognition under the name of HARIMATI BALIKA VIDYALAY. Aim was to provide education to Bengalis in their own language. It received temporary recognition for High School and Intermediate from UP Board in 1933 by the name – JUBILEE GIRLS SCHOOL. Permanent recognition was granted in 1944 for High School and in 1947 for Intermediate Classes.

The Degree Section came into existence in 1955 as an affiliated College of University of Lucknow. It is run by a Managing Committee registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860. Right from the beginning the Management has had world famous luminaries like Dr. Rudha Kamal Mukherjee, Dr. Radhakumud Mukherjee, Sri. A.C. Banerjee etc. Foremost among them was Sri Atul Prasad Sen an advocate, poet, lyric, singer, composer (63 geet) social worker, educationist, philanthropist and literateure in short, a versatile genius and a multifaceted personality. It was after him that the name of the college was converted from JUBILEE GIRLS DEGREE COLLEGE to A. P. SEN MEMORIAL GIRLS DEGREE COLLEGE.

Post graduate classes started in 2001 making it a PG College. The journey does not stop here. Today several research scholars in almost all departments are actively pursuing their research for doctoral degree under the able guidance of well qualified faculty of A.P. Sen Memorial Girls PG College.

Keeping in mind the problem of students, college has started a study centre of Uttar Pradesh Rajarshi Tandon Open University in January 2024. 56 courses ranging from Master to Bachelors, Diploma to Certificate and awareness programme are offered here.

National Service Scheme "Motto - Not me but you"

Two units of N.S.S. are active in the college. The scheme was lunched in Gandhi's centenary year 1969. Aimed at developing the personality of the students through community service, NSS is a voluntary association of young people in college, universities and at +2 level working for a campus - community linkage. The cardinal principle of the NSS program is that it is organized by the students themselves and both students, and teachers through their combined participation in the community service, get a sense of involvement in the task of nation - building.

Objectives of NSS : *To enable the student to understand the community in which they work. To understand themselves in relation to their community. To identify the needs and problems in the community in the solution of which they can be involved. To develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility. Abhyudaya Yojana Centre

Mukhyamantri Abhyudaya Yojana is a scheme of the Government of Uttar Pradesh which was launched on 24th January 2021 . The main objective of this yojana is to provide free coaching to students for competitive examination like IAS, IPS, PCS, NDA, CDS, NEET etc. Through this scheme, all those students who are unable to avail expensive outstation coachings due to financial and family constraints will benefit. A P Sen Memorial Girls' PG College has been made a centre for this scheme. It was inaugurated by Divisional Commissioner of Lucknow, Dr. Roshan Jacob on 12th January 2023. Boys and girls of the college and from outside can avail of free coaching in the centre by just filling a form absolutely free of cost. Two classes of 90 minutes each are held in the campus daily. The scheme is run by the Department of Social Welfare and Motivational lectures are given by senior IAS Officers. Online classes are also arranged during examination. The facility is normally provided during college hours only. Any aspirant, irrespective of class or caste can apply.

Scholarship

Eligible students with 75% of biometric attendance in the college can apply online for Post matric scholarship on the portal (For details check Government website for scholarship). A Printout of the online application will then be submitted in the college office with the following documents within time. An account in SBI is a must.

Course on Computer Concept (CCC)

Duration : 80 Hours - (Theory - 32 hrs + Practical - 48 hrs)

This course can also be offered as 10 days full time intensive course.

Eligibility : No minimum qualification is required for applying and appearing for the examination in Course on Computer Concepts (CCC).

Job Role : Computer Operator, Data Entry Operator and Social Media Operator.

Detailed Syllabus : 1. Introduction to computer 2. Introduction to operating system 3. Word processing 4. Spread sheet 5. Presentation 6. Introduction to internet and www 7. E-mail, social networking and e-governance services 8. Digital financial tools and applications 9. Overview of future skills & cyber security.

'O' Level (IT) Course

Duration of the Course : The duration of 'O' level (IT) course is 520 learning hours and the minimum period to cover contents is one year for candidates undergoing 'O' Level after 10+2 and 6 months for candidates undergoing 'O' Level after Graduation.

Practical : The students have to devote 60% of the total time allotted to each module of the course for the practical sessions. Practical assignments have been worked out for each theory module. The Practical examination will be based on the syllabi M1-R5, M2-R5, M3-R5 and M4-R5 modules of 'O' Level course.

Project : 'O' Level (IT) courses has a project as an important component. The project is carried out by the student under guidance and support of faculty and management of Institute / Organization where the student is undergoing training. It is felt that such a project provides an opportunity to the student to apply his / her knowledge and skills to real life problems (including oral and written communication skills). The project should be given utmost importance and priority both by the students as well as institution faculty / management in respect of its identification, planning and implementation.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

BA (NEP) 4 year Programme – 8 Semesters

1. Eligibility Criterion :

- Students seeking admission in BA (NEP) must have passed Intermediate examination of UP Board or equivalent examination recognised by University of Lucknow.
- बी.ए. (एनइपी) में प्रवेश के इच्छुक छात्राओं ने यू पी बोर्ड अथवा लखनऊ विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा मान्यता प्राप्त संस्था से इण्टरमीडियेट की परीक्षा पास की हो।
- If the candidate has passed out from Hindi Sahitya Sammelan Prayagraj and has not passed Intermediate exam with English language, then she will not be eligible for admission.
- यदि छात्रा ने हिन्दी साहित्य सम्मेलन प्रयागराज से बिना अंग्रेजी विषय पढ़े हुए इण्टरमीडियेट की परीक्षा उत्तीर्ण की है तो वह बी ए में प्रवेश के लिए अर्ह नहीं होगी।
- The request for refund of fees for withdrawal from the course shall only be entertained if made within 30 days from the date of admission. The refund is subject to 10% deduction of fee deposited, provided the student has not attended classes.
- कोर्स न करने पर फीस वापसी के लिए अनुरोध, प्रवेश लेने के 30 दिन के अन्दर ही स्वीकार किया जाएगा। 10% कटौती के बाद ही वापसी होगी, वो भी तब जब छात्रा ने क्लास नहीं अटेंड की हो।
- The minimum requirement for General and OBC candidates is 40% of marks and for SCs and STs it is 33% of marks in Intermediate or equivalent examination.
- इण्टरमीडियेट या समकक्ष परीक्षा में सामान्य एवं ओ.बी.सी. वर्ग के अभ्यर्थियों को कम से कम 40% तथा अनुसूचित जाति / जनजाति के अभ्यर्थियों के लिए न्यूनतम प्राप्तांक 33% अनिवार्य है।

ELIGIBILITY CRITERION:

Intermediate or equivalent examination with Commerce or Intermediate or equivalent with economics or mathematics as one of the subject of study – For General and OBC candidates, a minimum of 40% marks is required while for SC and ST candidates a minimum of 33% marks is required for admission.

STRUCTURE FOR UG (NEP) PROGRAMMES :
